Project Child - Project Child is a coalition of Lehigh Valley-based agencies established in 1991 with a mission of eliminating child abuse and neglect in the Lehigh Valley. Core programs include:

- Weekly parenting education classes and support groups where parents learn positive parenting skills and methods to support healthy family function
- Public speaking and educational materials to educate the community about child abuse prevention topics
- Weekly column, *Help for Families*, appearing in The Morning Call
- Learning to Care, a unique school-based Kindergarten program that teaches empathy and nurturing in the context of learning about child development, communication of needs and emotional awareness
- Professional Education Programs featuring renowned authorities on topics related to child abuse

Project Child is a program of Valley Youth House, an agency with a 41-year history as the community's first line of defense for troubled young people and their families. Protection from abuse, neglect and family disintegration is achieved through strategies involving prevention, crisis intervention and long-term help. Well-researched, outcomes driven program enable youth to work through challenges to establish and pursue constructive life-paths.
